Unified School District 292 covers an area of 437 square miles of Gove County in north-west Kansas. USD 292 serves the communities of Grainfield, Gove and Park with a district wide enrollment of approximately 100 students. USD 292 participates in an academic cooperative agreement with Grinnell USD 291. As part of this agreement, each district operates a PK—4 building and all students in grades 5—8 attend Grinnell Middle School while all students in grades 9—12 attend Wheatland High School.

The Wheatland school district offers a rigorous academic program that is challenging while providing the balance necessary for a well rounded educational experience. Small class sizes offer greater opportunities for individualized and differentiated instruction and enable teachers to better address the individual academic needs of each learner.

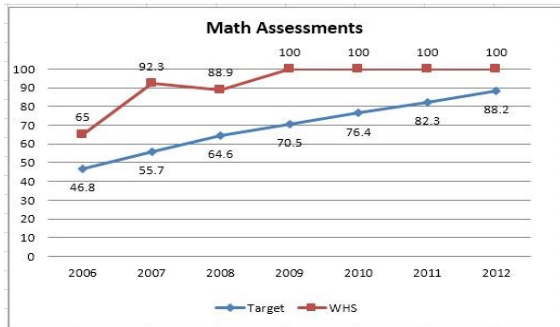
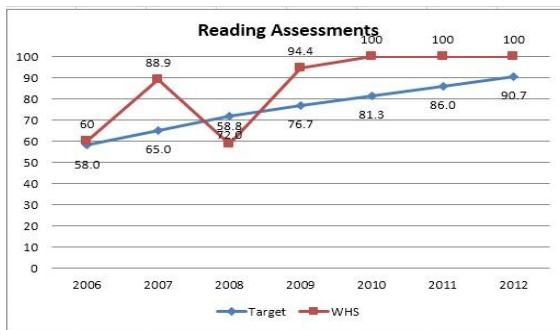

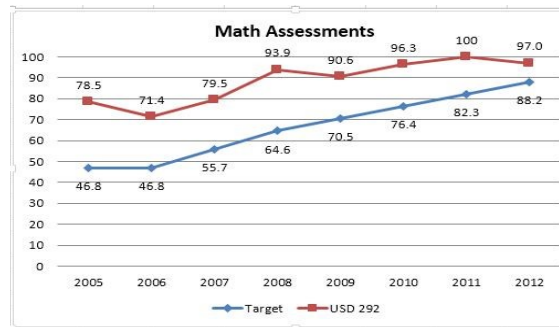
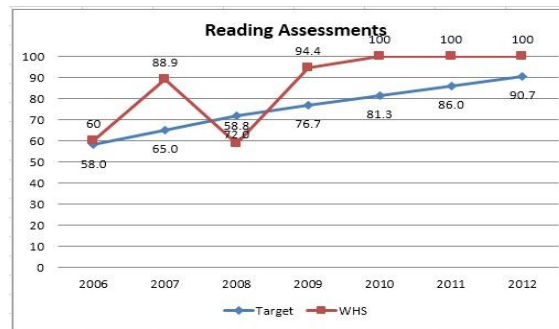


Wheatland High was recognized as a recipient of the Governor's Achievement Award in 2012-2013. This award is given annually to the top 5% of schools in Kansas.

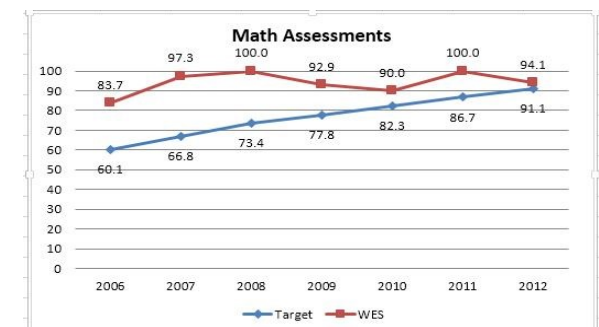
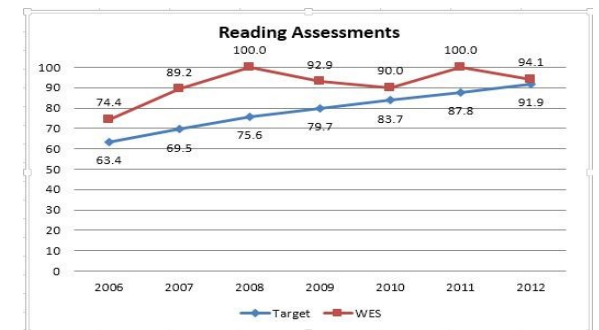
